At this time it is clear that we simply cannot provide an in-person member and attendee experience that will be completely safe, comfortable, or that will meet the multitude of goals associated with hosting our signature annual event. While this was a very difficult decision to make, I heartily support the board's choice and will wait patiently until we can see one other again next year in Fort Lauderdale in November.

So, what's next? The conference committee is hard at work planning our second virtual experience, which will take place from November 2-4, 2021 from approximately 11:00 am ET -6:00 pm ET each day.
